GAMBLING ACT 2005 - STATEMENT OF PRINCILPES CONSULTATION

Notification had been received from West Berkshire Council of a consultation required under the Gambling Act 2005. In its capacity as the Licensing Authority, West Berkshire Council must formulate a new Statement of Principles at least every 3 years. The last Statement of Principles was produced and became effective from January 2022. This policy therefore needed to be reviewed by the end of January 2025. The consultation period would run Thursday 18th July 2024 to 12th September 2024.

RESOLVED to respond to the consultation seeking clarification on statistics on monitoring of 'Vulnerable Persons' as detailed on page 14 of the consultation, and how were vulnerable people identified.
